### Erratum - 13 July 2015

Following the publication of the European Red List of Birds<sup>1</sup>, the EU population status of 14 bird species have been revised and a further one species was assigned EU population status, achieving compatibility with BirdLife International's current taxonomy<sup>2</sup> (*Hippolais opaca* was erroneously lumped with *Hippolais pallida*). The table below shows the relevant species and EU population status and Contribution to target 1 corrections.

**The Art 12 web tool currently displays incorrect information on EU population status and Contribution to Target 1 for 15 bird species listed in the table below.**
